PSL-21 replaces PSL-15

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to outdoor lighting services for individual members in localities where service can be supplied from DSO's existing facilities.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Alternating current, 60 cycles, 115-volt multiple circuits.

RATE

Member shall pay DSO each month for such lighting service at the following monthly rates:

The member shall reimburse DSO for any excess cost over the above per lamp cost, or the above charges may be increased 2.0% of DSO's actual investment in such installation above the amount per lamp listed above.

MAINTENANCE AND OWNERSHIP

DSO shall own and maintain the entire light system.

ADDITIONAL FACILITIES

<u>Equipment installed prior to April 2003</u>: Equipment, such as poles or, shall have an additional charge or \$1.40, unless a different amount was specified in the rental light service agreement.

Equipment installed from April 2003 and prior to January 2007: Equipment, such as poles or conductor, shall have an additional charge or \$4.20, unless a different amount was specified in the rental light service agreement.

<u>Effective January 2007</u>: If a member requests service under this schedule where a DSO-owned structure is not available, then the member shall be required to make a contribution-in-aid-of-construction equal to the estimated cost of the required facilities.

PAYMENT

Payment terms are specified in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of DSO.
