Residential – Rural Interruptible

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to rural members of DS&O for general, farm, and residential service.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase, at available voltages.

RATE

Availability Charge \$37.50 per month Energy Charge \$0.094 per kWh

Interruptible Credit \$25.00 per kW saved on Peak Day (minimum of 1 kW)

Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) see Schedule PCA

If required transformer capacity is greater than 25 kVA, then Availability Charge will be an additional \$15.21 per month.

DEFINITIONS

<u>Control Peak Period</u> is 3:00 p.m. CST to 6:00 p.m. CST, Monday through Friday, during the months of July and August (excluding July 4).

<u>Peak Day</u> is the day with the highest hourly measured demand during the Control Peak Period used by KEPCo to bill DS&O.

 $\underline{kW \ Saved} = (Peak \ Day \ kW \ reading at the end of the hour immediately before power being turned off + Peak Day kW reading at the end of the hour immediately after power being turned off)/2.$

TERMS OF SERVICE

- DS&O may turn off power to the member's meter any time during the Control Peak Period.
- DS&O may turn off power on multiple days, but there is only one Peak Day.
- DS&O shall notify members at least 30 minutes prior to power being turned off and such notifications shall be communicated via the member's preferred method, including email, text, or phone call.
- To receive the Interruptible Credit, the kW saved shall be 1 kW or more on Peak Day.
- The Interruptible Credit shall be paid in the next billing period after August usage.

MONTHLY MINIMUM BILL

Same as Availability Charge.

LIMITATIONS

Service under this rate is limited to 10,000 kWh per month.

PAYMENT

Payment terms are specified in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of DS&O.
